CWDC REPORT

The College has formed a CWDC, as per UGC guidelines and instructions from the ShriGovind Guru University Godhra, to prevent and deter the commission of any act of harassment, including sexual harassment, and to provide the procedure for resolution, settlement, or prosecution of acts of sexual harassment by taking all required steps. CWDC ensures protection of rights and privileges of girl students and female faculty members, and acts as a grievance redressal cell for female students and staff members. It facilitates empowerment and upliftment of girl students by conducting workshops and lectures to enhance their latent skills and increase their knowledge along with awareness of their rights. It also encourages gender sensitization and equality among students. The college has planned and organized many activities under CWDC (Collegiate Women Development Cell). Due to CWDC the female students have lot of freedom to correspond with the CWDC committee members regarding any issues pertaining to female students studying in the college. The cell members encourage female students to represent any issues and problems related to them. Due to the CWDC at college level the students are encouraged and motivated to participate in different kinds of activities organized by the college.

June -2017 to May - 2018

- The college has organized Rangoli Competition under the cell. The better performers were taken to Youth festival. On dated 23/01/2018 Rangoli and clay modeling competition was organized by the Collegiate Women's Development Cell. Five Students in Rangoli and Four students in clay modeling have participated in the program and it was displayed to all the students of the college to get motivated and they can also participate in future.
